Monthly Fees and Cancellations:

All payments due by the first lesson of each month. Monthly fees are based on a minimum of 30 and maximum of 36 weekly lessons spread over 10 months. If classes are less than 6 students, they may be changed to 45 minutes. A **\$12.00 late fee** is applied to all tuition received after the second lesson of each month. Music and vocal privates require a minimum of 24 hours cancellation, or forfeit class fee. Private music and vocal lessons are paid for the month to reserve your time slot.

Student Attire

A student's proper attire and attendance is not only a responsibility to themselves, but to their classmates. No jewelry or other attire that could cause injury is allowed in the studio. Dancers should be wearing clothes that allow them to dance freely without injuring themselves or others. **NO JEANS ALLOWED!** Students should wear tights at all times!
